Fundraiser Back at the Garden Pavilion!

The 2010 Scholarship Fundraiser was a success again in many ways. First of all, we were very grateful that the Oregon Garden Resort extended an open hand in friendship and offered a fair rental cost and allowed us to continue our long standing relationship with the Wooden Nickel Catering service. The Resort also offered discounted room rates for anyone attending our Fundraiser. It is my understanding that several Alumni stayed at the Resort and very much enjoyed the rooms and the many included amenities. The close proximity to the Pavilion was an added bonus.

A special thanks to the many loyal Alumni and Friends in attendance. We had 311 present for a good time with 58 of those purchasing his/her ticket on Friday the day of the Fundraiser. That was an all-time high for last minute ticket sales. We also had a record low of non-attendees by those who had purchased advance tickets with only 10 not attending.

Also especially important in these tough economic times was the continuing support of our Silent Auction by many Alumni and faithful corporate sponsors. A separate article in this Newsletter gives special recognition to the many loyal donors.

Our 50/50 Drawing had a very unique ending this year. As the winner, Morris Jones, was announced, he immediately offered to make a donation of his entire winnings to the Scholarship Fund.

Marcia Branstetter purchased a Wii and donated it with the idea of holding a Raffle to permit everyone, including those not attending the Fundraiser, to participate in the fund raising efforts. The Raffle was a success and if anyone desires to continue the process with a donation of something similar for next year, then please contact us with your offer as soon as possible so we can include the information in our Spring 2011 Newsletter. A Wii or portable GPS would be nice. Winner of the Wii was Jane Hande Barnard.

Since the purpose of our Fundraiser is to raise scholarship money, many have expressed a desire to know just how well we did.

A few have expressed a concern for the \$30 price for the tickets. It is very important to note that the Wooden Nickel gives us a tremendous discount and in fact reduced their total Invoice by a significantly generous \$2,923 donation. That amounts to a \$9.40 reduced cost per person. In other words, without the Wooden Nickel donation the real

profit per person on the party alone would be \$2 per person. So our \$30 cost of tickets only nets us a real net profit prior to computing the donations of approximately \$622 with 311 attending the Fundraiser.

The marvelous story associated with our Fundraiser is the extra money raised through the efforts of our volunteers and generous donors. The giving spirit is alive and well in the Foxes Den with the following report:

The approximate \$10,231 will go a long way towards meeting our 2010 scholarship obligation of \$54,750. Just a note on how we determine the amount to award in annual scholarships. We compute 5% of our invested principal as of Dec 31st and that amount is obligated for scholarships. Over time, a 5% annual withdraw has proven to leave the original invested principal whole.

I couldn't be more proud of all the accomplishments that have progressed since the beginning of this SHSAA (1996), starting with one Scholarship of \$100.00 and

now this past year of 36 awards to the first graduating Seniors at the new Silverton High School (\$15,000.00 worth). The merging of the Silver Fox High School Foundation funds and several major donors, plus numerous smaller donors as well has brought our propitious Alumni Scholarship Fund to over **\$800,000.00**, with roughly 5% of funds going to awards each year.

To our knowledge, no *high school has accomplished this milestone before* in such a short time.

It has been a great honor to have presented the awards at the high school these past 4 years. *Total amount of awards presented this year* from 60 or so presenters was (get this) **\$ 2,375,320.00**. Some were 4-year awards to a class of 262 graduating Seniors in 2010.

At press time, negotiations are still ongoing for the Oregon Garden for the 2011 Alumni Annual Scholarship Fundraiser.

Tracy Duerst and John Smith are heading up a financial committee of several prominent advisors to help guide our investment portfolio.

It has been voted that we should enter in next year's homecoming parade, to show support and get more exposure of our Alumni Scholarship Program.

One more thank you for all those not mentioned by name for all your volunteering of your time and effort. We could not have accomplished all these things without you.

To all those Alumni's attending our Fundraiser, thanks for attending and hope you had a great time enjoying past acquaintances and the festivities. Looking forward to our next great year, 2011.

School Yells and Songs

The Class of 1960 was searching for the words for "Cheer Cheer" for their reunion and asked everyone they could think of. While I was manning the booth in the park, I asked several of the Silverton High students who walked past. They'd never heard of the song. One of them told me "they ruled that out in ____." I don't remember the year he quoted.

After thinking about where that might have been printed, I finally found my Student Handbook, tucked away in an album from my high school days. The following is quoted from the Student Handbook, 1957-1958, page 26. I believe we added a line to the end of "Orange and Black". It was the first line repeated.

Quoting from that handbook:
School Yells and Songs

Athletic contest are attended by a large number of adults and visiting students. Their impression of our school is often gained by the way in which the student rooting section performs.

Every student sitting in the Silverton section should do his part by enthusiastically following the direction of your yell leaders.

It is the obligation of every student to know the school song "Cheer, Cheer, for Old Silverton."

**Spinach-Strawberry Salad**

- 2 T. sesame seeds
- 1/4 C distilled white vinegar
- 1 T. poppy seeds
- 1/4 tsp paprika
- 1/2 C white sugar (I normally cut this back)
- 1/4 tsp Worcestershire sauce
- 1/4 C olive oil
- 1 T. minced onion
- 10 ounces fresh spinach - rinsed, dried and torn into bite-size pieces
- 1 qt. strawberries - cleaned, hulled & sliced
- 1/4 C almonds, blanched and slivered

In a medium bowl, whisk together the sesame seeds, poppy seeds, sugar, olive oil, vinegar, paprika, Worcestershire sauce and onion. Cover and chill for one hour.

In a large bowl, combine the spinach, strawberries and almonds. Pour dressing over salad, and toss. Refrigerate 10 to 15 minutes before serving.

Makes 4 servings. I normally do a double batch for larger groups; you'll have leftover dressing.

**Sweet corn bread**

- 1 1/2 cups flour
- 2/3 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup corn meal
- 1 T. baking powder
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1 1/4 cup milk or buttermilk
- 2 eggs
- 1/3 cup oil
- 3 T. melted butter

Mix well. Bake in greased pan at 350° for 18 to 20 minutes.

**POPPYSEED CHICKEN**

*Jacque Wiesner '58*

- 1 Tbls. Butter
- 2 8-oz. Pkg. Sliced mushrooms
- 7 cups chopped, cooked chicken
- 2 cans cream of chicken soup
- 2 cups sour cream
- 1 cup slivered almonds, toasted
- 1 Tbls. Poppyseeds

Topping:

- 2 cups butter-flavored crackers, crushed (Ritz)
- 3 Tbls. butter, melted

Alternate topping: small can French-fried onions

Preheat oven to 375°. Spray 9x13 pan with non-stick cooking spray.

In large skillet melt butter. Add mushrooms & saute until soft. Remove from heat. Mix the chicken & other ingredients in a mixing bowl. Pour into baking dish & cover with foil. Bake 15 minutes. Uncover & bake for 10 minutes or until bubbly.

Topping: Mix Ritz cracker with melted butter and sprinkle over cooked casserole.

Option: may be served over rice. (I don't do that)

**Carrots au Gratin**

*Dave & Marie Legard '70*

Carrots are cooked with chopped onion and bell pepper, topped with Parmesan and cracker crumbs

Cook Time: 20 min

- 4 tablespoons melted butter, divided 2 1/2 to 3 cups slices carrots
- 1/4 cup saltine cracker crumbs
- 1/4 cup chopped green bell pepper
- 2 tablespoons grated Parmesan cheese
- 3 tablespoons chopped onion
- dash pepper

In a small bowl, toss 2 tablespoons of melted butter with cracker crumbs, Parmesan cheese and the pepper; set aside. Cook carrots, green pepper and onion in salted boiling water just until tender. Drain. Stir in remaining 2 tablespoons butter. Top carrots au gratin with buttered crumbs.

This recipe serves 4 to 6

**Berry Cobbler**

- 4 cups blackberries
- Juice of 1/2 lemon
- 3 Tbls. butter
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1 cup flour
- 1/4 tsp. salt
- 1 tsp. baking powder

Grease 8" square pan. Pour in berries, sprinkle with lemon juice. Make batter of butter, sugar, milk, flour, salt and baking powder. Pour over berries.

Topping:

- 1 cup sugar 1 Tbls. cornstarch
  - 1/4 tsp. salt 1 cup boiling water
- Pour boiling water over all. Bake 350° for one hour.
