# SHSAA Scholarship Fundraiser for 2012

Wonderful news!

The Festhalle (Festival Hall) in Mt. Angel is completed and available for our Fundraiser to be held on Aug 3, 2012. This brand new building offers ground floor facilities with plenty of parking immediately available – no stairs and no long walks required. We have been looking for

a "home" for our Fundraiser and this just might prove to be the ideal facility.

The Festhalle stands at the same location – 500 S. Wilco Hwy. – on the Silverton side of Mt. Angel as the former Oktoberfest beer hall. The former "tin barn" that had served as the Beer Hall since 1972 has been replaced with a marvelous new structure. The new hall is spacious, with

attention paid to acoustics, air flow, public facilities, parking, food and beverage service stations and pleasing landscaping. The stage and sound system are of professional quality. We are excited to explore the new facility as we hold the 2012 Fundraiser.

For you loyal attendees you know we have struggled, without success in recent years to convince the Oregon Garden Resort to maintain the mutually advantageous relationship that existed during the first eleven years that we held the event at the Oregon Garden. Several representatives of the SHS Alumni Association Board attempted without success to make a reservation for 2012 at the Oregon Garden Pavilion. The attitude of the Pavilion Manager at the Oregon Garden Resort was in stark contrast to the Festhalle personnel who were very cooperative in making our Fundraiser a priority on their schedule. It is clear



that the very strong spirit of community support, demonstrated by the Oktoberfest, remains evident in the Festhalle Manager's professionalism.

We also are very appreciative of Cooley's Gardens for offering their facilities last year for a very successful Fundraiser. We conducted a survey of attendees and the clear majority expressed their satisfaction for a very successful event held at very good facility. Thank you Cooley's for the use of your Pavilion.

Fundraiser 2011 added nearly \$7,500 to the Scholarship Fund. The continued support of the Trustees, loyal Alumni and the many community businesses and citizens over these last 13 years is amazing. It is unbelievable that the SHSAA has had so much success in raising the Scholarship principal to around \$800,000.

Last year 70 Graduating seniors and Alumni were awarded scholar-

ships from the SHSAA and the Loar Fund – a cooperative effort managed by the SHSAA to ensure that the maximum awards will be distributed to deserving graduates of Silverton High.

Keep up the good work, Alumni, and make plans to attend the 14<sup>th</sup> SHS Scholar-

ship Fundraiser to be held on Aug 3, 2012 at the Festhalle in Mt. Angel. The Friday event kicks off the Homer Davenport Community Festival weekend activities, so plan on staying over and enjoying Silverton.

# How Can I be a Class Representative?

We are often asked about the list of Class Reps in the back of the newsletter. "What do I have to do?" is the most common question.

Relax - there are no "duties". A Class Representative is mainly a contact person for a designated class year.

We would presume that person would be keeping track of classmates in order to make preparations for a reunion. The more often you have a reunion, the easier it is to keep track of everyone.

It's a great help when the Class Rep is notified by anyone who moves or changes his/her name. And some classes have better luck than others.

In addition to editing the newsletter, I also keep the Alumni Database up to date. The Class Reps help by sending me the changes of address for their classmates. This is a constant job. I am always receiving Emails with address changes.

#### **Reunion Preparation:**

Most reunions are held after a 5-year period (5, 10, 15, 20, etc.). Each year we concentrate on whatever year ends in a 5-year period from the date of graduation. For instance for 2007, we mailed complimentary copies of the newsletter to all classes ending in 7 or 2.

We are sending complimentary copies of this Dec. newsletter to the classes ending in 2 and 7. Contact us if your class will have a reunion in 2012 as we will also send the June issue to the classes ending in 2 and 7.

Let this be a "heads up" to *you*. Start working on your mailing list

now. We suggest you begin with a list from the Alumni Association. Request a class roster, compare it with what information you currently have, and work with us from there. The Post Office does not forward our newsletters. If one is sent out with a bad address (i.e., to someone who has moved), the newsletter is returned to us at a cost of 50¢. If the move has been within the past six months, the Post Office will provide us with a current address. Many times, however, we pay for the return only to get it stamped with "Moved - No Forwarding Address" or "FOE" (forwarding order expired).

So let's work together. Contact me for a Class Roster. Let me help you get a head start on your reunion for next year. If you'd like to check our list, just send an Email to:

# **Pumpkin Cookies**

1 Cup brown sugar, firmly packed

1 cup pumpkin

½ cup cooking oil

1 tsp vanilla

2 cups flour

1 tsp baking soda

1 tsp baking powder

½ tsp salt

½ tsp cinnamon

½ tsp nutmeg

½ tsp pumpkin pie spice

1 cup raisins

Beat together sugar, pumpkin, oil, vanilla. Mix dry ingredients & add gradually. Fold in raisins.

Drop by teaspoonfuls on well-greased baking sheet. Bake at 350° for 15 minutes. Makes 3-4 dozen.

Note: There are *no eggs* in this recipe. I use a heavy duty mixer to blend everything. You can put a lot on a cookie sheet, as these do not spread - they rise. I always cook pumpkins & freeze them in October. I also double the recipe as they are so popular.

# Walnut Bourbon Balls

2 ½ cups finely crushed vanilla wafers (12 oz. pkg.)

1 cup powdered sugar

2 tbls cocoa

1 cup finely chopped walnuts

3 tbls. corn syrup

½ cup bourbon

Mix first four ingredients well. Add syrup, bourbon and mix well. Shape into one-inch balls, then roll in powdered sugar. Add more bourbon if it becomes too dry to form into a ball, just enough to moisten.

#### Cake

1 box Betty Crocker SuperMoist carrot cake mix

1 teaspoon vanilla

½ cup orange juice or water

4 eggs

½ cup vegetable oil

½ cup finely chopped nuts

1 can (8 oz) crushed pineapple in juice, undrained

½ cup coconut

1 teaspoon grated orange peel

½ cup chopped raisins

#### Frosting:

1-2 teaspoons orange peel, if desired

1 Container (1 lb) Betty Crocker Rich & Creamy cream cheese frosting

1. Heat oven to 350 degrees F (325 degrees F for dark or nonstick pans). Grease two 8 or 9 inch round cake pans or 13x9 inch pan and lightly flour or spray with flour.

2. In large bowl beat cake mix, orange juice, oil, pineapple, orange peel, vanilla and eggs on low speed 30 seconds. Beat ion medium speed 2 minutes. Stir in nuts, coconut and raisins. Pour into pans

3. Bake 8 or 9 inch rounds 30 to 35 minutes, 13x9 inch pan 37 to 43 minutes, or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool 10 minutes. Run knife around sides of pan to loosen cake; remove rounds from pans to cooling racks. Cool completely, about 1 hour.

4. Stir orange peel into frosting. Place 1 cake layer, rounded side down, on serving plate. Spread with about 1/3 cup frosting. Place other layer, rounded side up, on

top. Frost side and top of cake with remaining frosting or frost top of 13x9 inch cake. Store in refrigerator.

# **Holiday Bundt Cake**

1 c. pumpkin

1 tsp. cinnamon

3 eggs

½ c. water

½ c. vegetable oil

½ c. pecans, chopped

1 box spice cake mix

1 (3 ½ oz.) pkg. vanilla pudding

In 2 to 2 ½ quart bowl layer half the broccoli, cauliflower, raisins and walnuts. Repeat layers. Cover and chill. In a screw-top jar combine olive oil, vinegar, 1 tsp salt, the honey, basil, black pepper and red pepper. Cover tightly and shake well. Add dressing just before serving; toss to coat.
