Homer Weekend in Silverton

Homer weekend in Silverton is the place to be, the place to hold reunions, the place to reminisce, and the place to meet old friends as well as new. The marvelous concept of several Silverton HS Classes holding their reunions over the same weekend multiplies the opportunities for all to meet and greet so many from other present and past citizens and SHS Alumni as one attends the Homer Parade, City Park events, Davenport Races and so many other activities. The whole town puts out the Welcome Mat for everyone to come and enjoy.

However, one opportunity that is being missed by some is not attending the SHS Scholarship Fundraiser as their first Homer weekend event on the first Friday in August. The Fundraiser was initially conceived to provide an opportunity to bring all Alumni and friends together at one place at the

beginning of Homer Days weekend. This key opportunity to find others and make weekend plans knowing who is back in town adds an important dimension to celebrating in Silverton. How often have you heard someone say, "If I had only known that so-and-so was back in town we could have had a great time visiting with them." *or* "Did you see so-and-so over at _____ last night?"

The Fundraiser provides the venue for the concept of "meeting you at the same place same time next year"! Many Alumni make attendance at the annual event a highlight on their calendar because it conveniently brings so many friends together with a minimum effort – except, of course for all the work that the volunteers put into making the Fundraiser an enjoyable success.

Thanks to the continuing generosity of many community businesses and organizations, the price of admission to the Fundraiser is kept to an absolute minimum to

encourage attendance. The ticket prices are at a break even cost. It is a rarity to find such a fine reunion opportunity as the Fundraiser for such a low price. I challenge you to try and hold a reunion in such a fine facility as the Festhalle and have great food and beverage service provided by the likes of the Wooden Nickel for only \$30. The scholarship money raised at the Fundraiser comes from the Silent Auction, Raffle and 50/50 Drawing, not from the price of admission.

An additional benefit of attending the SHS Fundraiser is that the proceeds of your fun time go directly back to the Alumni community. Last year the SHS Alumni Association awarded 65 scholarships to about an equal number of graduating seniors as well as to alumni attending universities and community colleges across the land. The \$53,500 that was awarded comes from the interest earned on the Investment Fund and from the proceeds of the Fundraiser.

The SHSAA encourages you to make plans to return to Silverton for the Homer Davenport Community Festival. We also make a personal request that you include the Fundraiser in your reunion plans to support the next generation of Foxes Alumni. It is a Win-Win opportunity for all.

Class of '63 — Revisiting “The Reunion That Started It All”

“You know the SHSAA scholarship fund started with the Class of '63, right?”

I heard this statement at our '63 reunion planning meetings this summer just enough times to want to hear how it happened first hand, so I asked Mason to set up a meeting with those in the know.

On a recent late Friday afternoon, I was delighted to interview a retired Army lieutenant colonel, a former college professor, a rather serious gentleman with an MPA (masters in public administration) and the owner of a well-known local business. Here is the story, first hand.

Remember that super-fun reunion we had in 1993? - First class to do something useful with the money left over from the weekend festivities

As the local business owner tells it, several class members, including our now-departed pal Gene Laudette, were rehashing the

reunion, wondering what to do with the \$900 left after reunion expenses were paid. Of course the professor wanted to do something for the high school, but the group quickly discovered that \$900 couldn't do much of significance for the school.

Someone said, “Well, then let's do something for the students!”

Again, \$900 seemed too little to do anything worthwhile, but the MPA got to wondering whether other classes had small sums sitting around in various bank accounts, and whether they would be interested in consolidating the money to create a scholarship fund for Silverton High students.

The lieutenant colonel, who admitted to being “addicted” to organizing, says he started asking around, and the word got out, uncovering what he describes as “pent-up demand.” People with energy and ideas started stepping forward asking, “What can I do?”

What they did became the Silverton High School Alumni Association and scholarship fund. In 1996, they published the first newsletter and awarded the first scholarship of \$100.

“After that it went crazy,” says the business owner. He compared the ensuing developments to popping popcorn in the microwave — first a single idea, then one or two more, then a veritable explosion of ideas and people.

The real explosions came in the form of generous donations of not just money, but time — many of the donors becoming “key cogs” in the organization to this day. Add the net profits from the annual fundraiser, and the merging of funds from existing SHS scholarship programs (most notably the Errol and Eaden Ross scholarship fund in early 2010) and today's

SHSAA scholarship program can really do something for students.

Each year the Association receives an average of 110 applications, this year awarding a total of \$53,500 — a far cry from that first year's solo “Franklin.”

Why am I telling you all of this?

The first reason is a bit self-serving. Next year is a big-year reunion for my class, the Class of '63. (You do the math.) I want to encourage my classmates to join us as we revisit the activities of “the reunion that started it all” and more — August 2, 3 and 4, 2013 here in Silverton. (Classmates, see insert in your newsletter for details.) We have purposefully planned our big-year reunion to include Friday to make it easy to get to SHSAA fundraising event. It's a hoot seeing people from other classes and catching up with them, too.

The other reason, to steal a notion from that first SHSAA newsletter, is to put the “U” back in SHS. We graduated from SUHS, which was changed to SHS in 1997. We encourage “U” to support the SHSAA with your membership, your donations, your time and/or your participation in the fundraising event. Scholarships are limited to a small percent of the interest of the invested principal, plus the net profit from the fundraiser — mainly donations and the silent auction. Despite popular notions, no profit is made from the cost of the meal, kept as low as possible due to generous contribution by Glen Damewood and company.

If U are also planning a reunion in 2013, we encourage U to schedule during Homer Davenport weekend, so we can see U and your classmates Friday night at the SHSAA shin-dig. (This year it was

at the new Mt. Angel Festhalle — a big hit.) Then come watch the infamous Class of '63 as we ride in the Homer Davenport parade, splash orange paint on the senior bench at the new high school, and joyfully celebrate our common history.



How Can I be a Class Representative?

We are often asked about the list of Class Reps in the back of the newsletter. "What do I have to do?" is the most common question.

Relax - there are no "duties". A Class Representative is mainly a contact person for a designated class year.

We would presume that person would be keeping track of classmates in order to make preparations for a reunion. The more often you have a reunion, the easier it is to keep track of everyone.

It's a great help when the Class Rep is notified by anyone who moves or changes his/her name. Check your class year - if it says "Rep Needed", we are asking for a volunteer for that class.

In addition to editing the newsletter, I also keep the Alumni Database up to date. The Class Reps help by sending me the changes of address for their classmates. This is a constant job. I am always receiving Emails with address changes.

Reunion Preparation:

Most reunions are held after a 5-year period (5, 10, 15, 20, etc.). Each year we concentrate on whatever year ends in a 5-year period from the date of graduation.

For instance for 2007, we mailed complimentary copies of the newsletter to all classes ending in 7 or 2.

We are sending complimentary copies of this Dec. newsletter to the classes ending in 3 and 8. Contact us if your class will have a reunion in 2013 as we will also send the June issue to those classes holding a reunion.

Let this be a "heads up" to you. Start working on your mailing list now. We suggest you begin with a list from the Alumni Association. Request a class roster, compare it with what information you currently have, and work with us from there. The Post Office does not forward our newsletters. If one is sent out with a bad address (i.e., to someone who has moved), the newsletter is returned to us at a cost of 50¢. If the move has been within the past six months, the Post Office will provide us with a current address. Many times, however, we pay for the return only to get it stamped with "Moved - No Forwarding Address" or "FOE" (forwarding order expired).

So let's work together. Contact me for a Class Roster. Let me help you get a head start on your reunion for next year. If you'd like to check our list, just send an Email to: Nunnjk@comcast.net. Be sure to put your **class year in the subject line**. You may phone me with the request at (503) 390-3816 - leave a message if I'm not home and **PLEASE be sure to leave your area code and phone number** in case I have to contact you.

**Cran-Burgundy Mold**

*Paulette Plank Olson '61*

This recipe has been a Christmas and Thanksgiving favorite of our family for many years.

- 1 6oz package of raspberry gelatin
  - 1 cup boiling water
  - 1 1-pound can jellied or whole cranberry sauce
  - 1 13-1/2 ounce can crushed pineapple, undrained
  - 3/4 cup Burgundy or Merlot wine
  - 2/3 cup chopped pecans
  - 1 cup chopped celery (optional)
- Dissolve gelatin in boiling water; blend in cranberry sauce. Stir in undrained pineapple and wine. Chill until slightly thickened. Add nuts and celery.
- Turn into 6 to 8 individual molds or one round mold. Chill until firm.
- Unmold on crisp greens. Good with turkey or ham.

**Pecan-pie Muffins**

*Donna Krug Ramseyer Liechty '41*

- 1 cup light brown sugar, firmly packed
  - 1/2 cup all-purpose flour
  - 1/2 cup chopped pecans
  - 2 eggs, beaten
  - 2/3 cup butter, softened
- Preheat oven to 350° F. Line muffin cups with paper muffin liners. In bowl stir together brown sugar, flour and pecans. In separate bowl beat eggs and butter together until smooth. Stir into dry ingredients until just combined. Spoon batter into muffin cups, about 2/3 full. Bake for 20 to 25 minutes. Cool on wire racks when done.

**Cheese Log**

*Donna Krug Ramseyer Liechty '41*

- 1 lb. Velveeta cheese, room temperature
  - 1 small can chopped green chiles, drained
  - 1 8 oz. cream cheese, room temperature
  - 1/2-1 tsp. onion powder
  - 1/2 cup bacon bits
- Between 2 pieces of aluminum foil (not waxed paper) roll out Velveeta cheese to 1/4 inch thick in rectangular shape. Smooth cream cheese over top. Sprinkle onion powder and about 1 tablespoon of bacon bits on cheese mixture. Smooth chiles over top. Roll as a jelly roll into a log.
- Tip:* Pick up edge of foil and slowly work away from foil, rolling to 3/4 of way. Bring other edge back over to form the log.

**Candied Strawberries**

*Marie (Milligan) Arthur '52*

- A favorite at Christmas
- 2 3-oz. packages of strawberry Jello
- 1 cup ground nuts
- 1 cup flaked coconut
- 5/8 cup sweetened condensed milk (1 can makes double batch)
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla
- Red decorator's sugar

Combine Jello, nuts and coconut. Stir in milk and vanilla and mix well. Chill one hour. Shape into small strawberries (about 1" long) and roll in red sugar. Pipe a little green icing on ends for stems. Makes 1 lb. 3 oz.

**Garlic Cheese Grits**

*Carmen Smith '61*

- 2 cups water
- salt & pepper to taste
- 1 cup quick cooking grits
- 1 roll garlic cheese
- 1/2 cup butter
- Worcestershire sauce
- Tabasco sauce
- 2 eggs, separated

Cook grits according to package directions. Remove from heat and sliced cheese and butter. After cooking a few more minutes, add egg yolks gradually one at a time, making sure that the yolks don't get hard. Season with salt, pepper, Worcestershire sauce and Tabasco sauce to taste. Beat egg whites until stiff and fold in the grits mixture.

Put mixture in greased 8" x 8" baking pan and bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes or until golden brown. Serves 4-6.

This dish makes a nice addition to Sunday brunch.

**Cherry Dessert**

*Bob Kouf '57 and his wife, Peggy.*

- 1 pint whipping cream, whipped.
- Add 4 cups mini marshmallows.
- Line a cake pan with crushed graham crackers or vanilla wafers and a little melted butter.

Spread 1/2 of the cream mixture over crumbs. Pour 1 can Cherry Pie Filling over this. Top with the rest of the cream mixture and sprinkle with graham cracker crumbs. Chill for several hours. Do not freeze. Yum!

Chocolate Surprise Cake

- 12 oz. cream cheese, softened
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1 egg 1/2 tsp vanilla extract
- 1 pkg. chocolate cake mix
- 1/2 cup semisweet chocolate mini-morsels

Heat oven to 350°. Butter & flour a 12-cup bundt pan. In a small mixing bowl, using an electric mixer, beat cream cheese and sugar until smooth. Add egg and vanilla; beat until blended and set aside. Prepare cake as label directs; fold in chocolate morsels. Pour chocolate batter into prepared pan; evenly cover with cream cheese mixture. Bake until a wooden pick inserted in the center of the cake comes out clean, 45 to 55 minutes. Cool on a wire rack for 25 minutes. Remove from pan; cool completely. Dust with confectioners' sugar. Serve with whipped cream and raspberries, if desired. Serves 12.

Rhubarb Upside-Down Cake

Carolyn Hutton '59

- 3 cups sliced rhubarb 1 cup sugar, divided
- 1/3 cup butter
- 1 1/2 tsp. baking powder
- 1 egg 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- 1/2 cup low-fat milk
- 1 1/4 cup flour
- Preheat oven to 350°

In large saucepan, combine rhubarb and 2/3 cup of the sugar. Cook over low heat, stirring frequently until sugar melts. Spread mixture over bottom of well-oiled 8 or 9-inch square baking pan.

In mixing bowl, beat butter with remaining 1/3 cup of sugar and

baking powder until mixture is fluffy.

Beat in egg and vanilla extract. Gradually add milk, alternating it with flour.

Blend ingredients well. Spoon batter evenly over fruit layer. Bake for approximately 35 minutes. Allow cake to cool in pan for 5 minutes. Run knife around edges of cake to loosen. Turn cake out of pan, upside down, onto a platter. From "The Providence and Rhode Island Cookbook" by Linda Beaulieu.

Butterscotch Poppysed Cake

- 1 Box yellow pudding in the mix cake mix
- 1 tsp almond extract
- 2 pkg instant butterscotch instant pudding
- 4 eggs
- 1 1/2 cup oil
- 1/4 cup poppyseeds (or not)
- 1 cup flat 7-up

Mix and pour into greased bundt pan. Bake 350° for 45-60 minutes. Check with toothpick. Can be sprinkled with powdered sugar or frosted.

Frosting: Cream together cream cheese, powdered sugar & lemon juice.

Note: I made it without the poppyseeds and it was great!

Lemon Cake

- 9 x 13" pan 350° - 35 min.
- 1 pkg. yellow cake mix
- 1 pkg. lemon Jello
- 3/4 cup water
- 4 eggs - beat 2 min. & add 3/4 cup Wesson oil. Combine 2 cups powdered sugar & 1/3 cup lemon juice, pour over cake while warm.

Mandarin Orange Cake

Dicy Strom Graham, '63

- 1 Yellow cake mix
- 1 can mandarin oranges (juice and all)
- 3/4 cup oil
- 3 eggs
- Mix well. Bake 350° for approx. 30 minutes. Cool.
- Topping:**
- 8 oz. Cool-Whip
- 1 Can crushed pineapple, include juice
- 1 Pkg. instant vanilla pudding or your choice

Mix and spread on cooled cake. You could add coconut or nuts on top, if desired. Especially perfect for those summer evenings!

Pudding Cake

- 2 Cups fresh or frozen blueberries, raspberries, blackberries or rhubarb

Place in 8" baking pan. Combine:

- 1 cup flour
- 3 Tablespoons melted butter
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- Pour over berries. Combine 3/4 cup sugar, 1 Tablespoon cornstarch, 1 cup boiling water. Pour over all. Bake at 350° for 45 to 55 minutes or until top tests done. Serves 9.
