SHS SCHOLARSHIP FUND DONATES ASSETS TO ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

Historically the Silverton High School Scholarship Fund (Fund) and the Silverton High School Alumni Association (Alumni) have shared a common purpose and have worked very closely for over ten years sharing the responsibility of administering two separate but redundant Scholarship programs. The effect of the redundancy has been excess expenses in the form of legal and professional fees as well as duplicate State fees for corporate registration and multiple other filings with several State and Federal agencies.

The Silverton High School Scholarship Fund was established in 1992 by Errol and Eaden Ross as a provision of their Estate. It was their goal to have a perpetual fund from which financial assistance could be offered in the form of scholarships to graduates of SHS as they pursue their undergraduate education goals.

In researching the prospect of combining their Fund with the Alumni, it was a matter of record that their primary intention was to have a viable and perpetual financial Fund and not to have a personal legacy or personal recognition.

The two redundant but devoted Boards of Directors for the organizations recognized that their scholarship programs could be more efficiently managed as one organization. Additionally, the very valuable volunteer hours could be more efficiently utilized by combining the organizations; thereby reducing actual Directors and Trustees by half. The financial savings from combining the two funds results in increased scholarship opportunity for future generations of SHS graduates and a more efficient use of volunteer resources.

The combination of the two programs actually strengthens the Fund's potential with an established base of Alumni donors to meet the State and Federal prerequisites so the Fund will continue as a Nonprofit public corporation. The ever increasing quantity and quality of donations has had a remarkably positive influence on the size of the invested principal.

The Alumni has historically demonstrated a proficient and

effective administration of a strong scholarship program, so the Fund offered and we agreed to accept the transfer of funds and to continue to administer them as our own.

Craig Roessler, Silver Falls School District Superintendent, supported the idea and assisted with the presentation of the concept before the Silver Falls School District Board. As soon as they approved of the process, the Fund was then dissolved and the ownership of their investment account was transferred to the Alumni Association.

The immediate effect of the contribution is that the investment account for the Association is now over \$800,000. What a tremendous growth since our humble beginning in 1996 with only \$900 in the bank.

Honorary Diplomas - Class of 2010 Craig Roessler

Craig Roessler began his career in public education as an Educational Assistant with the Salinas, California School District in 1971. He served at-risk junior high students and assisted students from foreign countries to learn English. He also volunteered at Hartnell Junior College teaching adults to speak and read English. Realizing his passion for teaching, Craig returned to the University of Oregon in 1974 to obtain his teaching license in social studies and math. His first teaching position was at Mt. Angel Middle School from 1975-80.

Craig earned his school administrator's license in 1980 from Portland State University, and was hired as the Assistant Principal in charge of discipline at the 1,300 student Molalla Elementary School. Craig was then hired in 1982 to serve as the Principal of Robert Frost School. After two years at Robert Frost, he transferred to Mark Twain. In 1987 Silverton Elementary SD employed Craig as its Superintendent, and in 1991 Silverton Union High SD *hired Craig as its Superintendent* too. He served as the Superintendent of the two school districts until the State mandated unification in June 1997. At that time, the local school districts were merged and Craig continued as Superintendent of newly named Silver Falls SD.

Craig has served on the Silverton Chamber Board, the Silverton Hospital Board, the Silverton Together Board, and on the boards of a variety of statewide educational organizations. In 2000 he was chosen as the Oregon Superintendent of the Year. Craig received the Distinguished Service Award this year at the First Citizens Banquet.

Craig has enjoyed his 28 years of service as school administrator in Silverton and the opportunities he has had to help make Silverton a great place for kids to learn and grow.

Gerald Russell Ott

Gerald Ott graduated from Washington State College in 1956 with a degree in Vocational Agriculture. Before beginning his teaching career he was drafted and served two years in the Army. He taught ten years in eastern Washington, first at Wilbur and then at Connell. Besides his teaching duties and work with the FFA, he spent many years refereeing football and basketball. He even found time to coach girls basketball. Gerald moved his family to Silverton in 1970.

At SUHS Gerald taught the Vocational Ag classes and advised the FFA Chapter. Over the next 20 years, the Chapter was one of the most successful in the State; winning many judging contests and turning out many State and American farmers. Every year they would attend the National FFA Convention usually having teams competing.

In addition to school activities, Gerald was a longtime member of the North Howell Grange. During his later years of teaching he also had a small dairy.

Gerald and his wife, Marilyn raised 4 children all graduating from SUHS and OSU. He retired from teaching in 1990 and later worked at Marion Ag Service in St. Paul. He passed away in May, 2008.

The Nickel's 2009 partial food sponsorship donation of \$3,002 continues to be the most significant single contribution to our annual scholarship "Garden Party" fundraising efforts. Please show your appreciation and give them a personal "thank you" the next time you are at either the Wooden Nickel or Mac's Place.

It is equally important to note that because of the Resort's waiver of their private caterer \$15 per attendee surcharge and their reduced rent for next year's event that in effect they will be contributing approximately \$8,000 in reduced fee savings to promote our return back to the Pavilion.

We did have less in attendance than is traditionally expected; however, those loyal Alumni who did attend had a very positive attitude and were very generous. The Silent Auction and 50/50 raffle bought in as much in scholarship funds as did previous Fundraisers where twice the number of Alumni attended.

We eagerly look forward to our future Scholarship Fundraisers with the hope that you will make it a point to put us on your calendar, reserve a room at the Resort, and have fun over the Homer Davenport Weekend. See Ya on August 6, 2010 at the Garden!

1 cup Crab or imitation
1 cup chopped celery
1 cup green peppers chopped
1 cup mayonnaise
1 cup chopped onion
Mix all ingredients together. Put

Broiled Tilapia Parmesan

½ cup Parmesan cheese
¼ cup butter, softened
3 tablespoons mayonnaise
1/8 teaspoon celery salt
2 tablespoons fresh lemon juice
¼ tsp ground black pepper
1/8 teaspoon onion powder
2 pounds tilapia fillets
¼ teaspoon dried basil

1. Preheat your oven's broiler. Grease a broiling pan or line pan with aluminum foil.

2. In a small bowl, mix together the Parmesan cheese, butter, mayonnaise and lemon juice. Season with dried basil, pepper, onion powder and celery salt. Mix well and set aside.

3. Arrange fillets in a single layer on the prepared pan. Broil a few inches from the heat for 2 to 3 minutes. Flip the fillets over and broil for a couple more minutes. Remove the fillets from the oven and cover them with Parmesan cheese mixture on the top side. Broil for 2 more minutes or until the topping is browned and fish flakes easily with a fork. Be careful not to over cook the fish.

Yields: 8 servings - Ready in 15 minutes

Silverton Alumni News How Can I be a Class Representative?

Relax - there are no "duties". A Class Representative is mainly a contact person for a designated class year.

We would presume that person would be keeping track of classmates in order to make preparations for a reunion. The more often you have a reunion, the easier it is to keep track of everyone.

It's a great help when the Class Rep is notified by anyone who moves or changes his/her name. And some classes have better luck than others.

In addition to editing the newsletter, I also keep the Alumni Database up to date. The Class Reps help by sending me the changes of address for their classmates. This is a constant job. I am always receiving Emails with address changes.

Reunion Preparation:

Most reunions are held after a 5year period (5, 10, 15, 20, etc.). Each year we concentrate on whatever year ends in a 5-year period from the date of graduation. For instance for 2007, we mailed complimentary copies of the newsletter to all classes ending in 7 or 2.

We'll send complimentary copies of this June newsletter to the classes ending in 0 and 5. Contact us if your class will have a reunion in 2011 as we will be sending the Dec. 2010 newsletter to the classes ending in 1 and 6.

Let this be a "heads up" to *you*. Start working on your mailing list now. We suggest you begin with a list from the Alumni Association. Request a class roster, compare it with what information you currently have, and work with us from there. The Post Office does not forward our newsletters. If one is sent out with a bad address (i.e., to someone who has moved), the newsletter is returned to us at a cost of 50¢. If the move has been within the past six months, the Post Office will provide us with a current address. Many times, however, we pay for the return only to get it stamped with "Moved - No Forwarding Address" or "FOE" (forwarding order expired).

So let's work together. Contact me for a Class Roster. Let me help you get a head start on your reunion for next year. If you'd like to check our list, just send an Email to: Nunnjk@comcast.net. 
