2011 Fundraiser to be held at Cooley's Gardens

When you are given lemons you make lemonade. We received the news in mid-December that the Oregon Resort had scheduled another organization to use the Pavilion on August 5, 2011 which was the date that we had thought was already on their calendar for our Scholarship Fundraiser.

We "dusted off" our file of alternative sites and took a fresh look with the location, size and accommodations being the primary considerations. Ideally the site would accommodate our expected 400 attendees, be in a location in or near Silverton and be economically viable.

The over-all expenses are very important considerations as we want to provide a maximum benefit to our members at a minimum cost and still provide for some fund raising for our Scholarship Program.

It is noteworthy that the Mount Angel Oktoberfest Beer Hall has been demolished this year and they are building a new facility to be completed for their 2011 festival; so that site was out of the question for this year. But we will keep it in mind for potential future use.

We considered the 7-Brides Brew Pub but it is too small and if we were to use it we would have to rent some portable toilets and a tent of adequate size to complement the existing inside seating area. Additional tables and chairs would also have to be rented. The fact that we would have multiple seating areas was not very satisfactory.

We asked the Silver Falls School District for a waiver to permit the consumption of alcohol in the old High School gym so we could have a "Prom-like" Fundraiser at the old school. They respectfully declined the request while also complimenting all of you for supporting such a just cause of providing financial support to the following generations of Foxes.

After much analysis, Rick Ernst offered us the opportunity to use one or more of his huge production sheds at Cooley's Gardens located at the NW corner of Silverton Road and Brush Creek Road, just a couple miles west of town.

The Board of Trustees visited the facility in February and confirmed that the site will be just fine. It offers the advantage over the Garden Pavilion of being near parking and more accessible for those of us who have some difficulty walking a distance. There is a huge paved area around the facility that provides the opportunity to be flexible in regards to how we will set up the affair. The costs will be kept at a minimum; however, we will have to rent tables, chairs and toilets.

Rick passed away suddenly March 2nd, but his wife, Kati, recently confirmed that she would be honored for all of us to participate in the Fundraiser at Cooley's Gardens. She said Rick had been excited about hosting it.

We are very concerned that everyone knows that we will be in a large pole barn and there just might be a possibility of a cool breeze after sunset. After all, this is Oregon and one should always be prepared for a chilly evening. So come prepared and wear something comfortable and casual – very casual and bring a light jacket or sweater for that added protection.

The Wooden Nickel is talking about bringing some free-standing fire pits so we can have a few log fires and stand around and kibitz and drink our favorite beverage.

We will also have the silent auction with many items from local merchants and alumnae. You sure don't want to miss this one!

We are looking forward to an extremely enjoyable evening of reminiscing and limitless opportunities to meet others from the old school. So make your plans to "come home" and attend the SHS Scholarship Fundraiser.

Shrimp Scampi

- 2 tablespoons butter
- 1 ½ tablespoons lemon juice
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- ½ cup dry white wine
- 4 large garlic cloves, minced pinch of dried hot red-pepper flakes

¹/₄ cup chopped fresh Italian (flat-leaf) parsley

1 pound large shrimp, shelled and deveined

salt

black pepper

- 1. Heat butter and oil in a heavy skillet over medium heat until foam subsides. Add garlic, parsley, lemon juice, wine, pepper flakes and salt and pepper to taste. Bring to a boil, lower heat and simmer for 3 minutes.
- 2. Add shrimp to skillet and cook, stirring frequently, for 5 to 6 minutes, until shrimp are pink. Remove from the heat. Place shrimp on a serving plate and pour sauce from the skillet over them. Serve immediately.

Favorite Casserole

- 2 Boneless chicken breasts, cubed and cooked
- 1 egg, beaten 1 can cream of mushroom soup
- 3 slices bread cubed 1 can chicken noodle soup

Mix all ingredients together. Pour into greased 9" x 9" casserole dish. Sprinkle 1 cup crushed Ritz cracker crumbs over top. Cover and bake for 45 minutes at 350°. Remove cover and brown in oven before serving.

Slow Cooker Sweet & Sour Pork (or Chicken)

1 1/2 lb. pork loin, cut into 1-inch pieces

1 can (14 oz.) pineapple chunks, drained

1 medium onion, chopped

1 medium green pepper, chopped

1 can (14 1/2 oz.) chicken broth

2 cups *Minute* white rice, uncooked 1 bottle (14 oz.) Kraft Sweet 'N Sour Sauce

Place pork (or chicken) in slow cooker; top with onion, broth and sweet 'n sour sauce. Cook on low for 8 to 10 hours. Add pineapple, green pepper and rice; mix well. Cover and cook an additional 20 minutes. Be careful not to overcook at this point. Makes 8 servings.

Spinach Madeline

2 packages frozen spinach, chopped

4 tablespoons butter

1/2 teaspoon salt

2 tablespoons flour

6 oz. roll Jalapeno's cheese

2 tablespoons chopped onion

1/2 cup evaporated milk

1/2 cup vegetable liquor

1/2 teaspoon black pepper

1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce

3/4 teaspoon celery salt

3/4 teaspoon garlic salt

Cayenne pepper to taste

Cook spinach according to package directions. Drain and reserve liquor. Melt butter in saucepan. Sauté onions then add flour, stirring until smooth and thick. Add seasonings, liquor, milk and sliced cheese. Stir until melted. Combine with spinach. May be served immediately or put into casserole and topped with bread crumbs and butter. Excellent if refrigerated overnight and then baked. Bake at 375 degrees for 30 minutes. Bake longer if the dish has been refrigerated. Serves 5-6.

This is a very nice vegetable dish. Especially good in the winter and around the holidays.

Lemon Mousse Pie

Nellie Graves '56

1 pie crust, baked & cooled

(I use graham cracker crust) Filling:

1 envelope unflavored gelatin

1/2 cup lemon juice

1/4 cup water

1 tsp. grated lemon peel

6 to 8 drops yellow food coloring

8 oz. softened cream cheese

1 cup powdered sugar

2 cups whipping cream, whipped

In saucepan, combine gelatin, lemon juice & water. Let stand 1 min. Stir over medium heat until dissolved. Stir in lemon peel & food color. In a bowl, combine cream cheese & powdered sugar; beat until smooth. Slowly add softened gelatin; blend. Chill until slightly thickened. Fold in whipped cream. Spoon into crust. Chill at least 1 hour. Store in refrigerator.
