The Davenport Project A Century after his Final Trip Home

One hundred years ago this May, the RMS Titanic's last victim died. W.R. Hearst cartoonist Homer Davenport caught his death waiting in the rain to illustrate the survivors' tragic tale. An incredibly lucky, creative and productive life was cut short two weeks later by pneumonia. To celebrate the memory of Silverton's original famous son, SUHS Alum Gus Frederick ('73) has initiated "The Davenport Project."

Over the course of the next several months leading up to August, The Davenport Project will present a series of lectures, exhibits, publications and general fun. All in the name of one of the most creative caricaturists who ever plied a pen to paper.

One of the key events will be a Lecture Series, featuring a number of different talks about the various aspects of the life and times of Davenport. These stories run wide and deep, and honor a relatively unknown aspect of Homer's career, that as a lecturer. In 1899 while on assignment in Europe, Davenport was introduced by African explorer Henry Morton Stanley to Major James Pond, the world-famous lecture manager. During this period of time, the "lecture circuit" provided a unique and varied form of entertainment: Listening to people talk on a variety of subjects.

Besides Stanley, Major Pond handled others such as Mark Twain, the then-young Winston

Churchill, and soon after, Davenport. As Pond surmised, Davenport was a natural. His subjects included the famous and powerful he cartooned, but also tales of his own early life, growing up in Silverton, Oregon. Many stories that eventually became his autobiography, "The Country Boy."

So it seems fitting that a major portion of The Davenport Project will consist of a series of dynamic lectures, comprising the wide range of topics surrounding Davenport's amazingly diverse life and times. These topics include but are not limited to, The Life and Times of Homer C. Davenport, Pioneer Silverton as Artistic Incubator and Timothy W. Davenport: Pioneer Oregon physician, surveyor, politician and social commentator.

Venues include the Jack London Bar and Oregon Convention Center in the Portland metro area, Salem and of course Silverton. During the Davenport Community Festival this August, the lecture series will move to GeerCrest Farm for the weekend. Check back on our website; we will post them as they gel.

And during the annual Homer Davenport Community Festival, (August 3-5), all your favorite activities will be back in town! The annual Parade, class reunion, crafts fair, Lions Breakfast and of course, The Davenport Races! And much, much more! So if you have been wondering if a trip back home to Silverton would be an option, this year might just be that year!

It is scholarship time again. Even though the world of investing has had its ups and downs, the Alumni Association and Loar Funds combined have earned enough this year to be able to award over \$50,000 in scholarships to this year's graduating seniors and post graduates enrolled in a college or university. The primary purpose of the Alumni Association is still to raise money for the fund so the earnings can be used for scholarships.

With the increasing cost of higher education, whatever we can make available to help students meet their goal of an advanced degree is to the benefit of our society. We have about 11,000 names on our mailing list. If everyone paid the annual membership fee of \$5.00, the cost of a fancy cup of coffee, that would put a total of \$55,000.00 in the fund. At our goal of 5% earnings, that is another \$2750 for scholarships. I encourage you all to become members.

Now it is time to make a pitch for some younger blood on the Association Board of Trustees. The January meeting is when board members are elected.

How Can I be a Class Representative?

Many times, however, we pay for the return only to get it stamped with "Moved - No Forwarding Address" or "FOE" (forwarding order expired).

and Wooden Nickel Catering Service. Every year he makes a very significant contribution to our Alumni Scholarship Fundraiser event. In recognition of his continuing generosity it is indeed a pleasure to award this scholarship.

Errol and Eaden Ross Scholarship – The Ross' family owned and operated the Shell heating oil and service station business in Silverton from 1930's for over 50 years. In 1993, the Ross Family Estate established an endowment from which annual scholarships may be awarded to alumni of SHS. Their Fund was merged with our Association in 2009 and remains today our most significant source for scholarship awards.

Noteworthy: The Dr. P. A. Loar Trust contributes approximately \$20,000 yearly to be managed and distributed by the Alumni Association. We typically award the LOAR funds to post-high school applicants and again this year we have made awards to 30 additional Alumni of SHS who are currently pursuing their undergraduate degrees.

This year our Alumni Association will be awarding \$53,000 in scholarships to graduating seniors and alumni attending post high school classes. We expect to distribute approximately 70 awards ranging from \$500 to \$1,500 to deserving Fox alumni.

All alumni continuing their pursuit of an undergraduate degree are encouraged to apply annually during early March of next year. The applications are available in a Word.doc format at our website: www.shsfoxes.com.

**Zucchini Casserole**

*Marcia & Mason Branstetter '63*  
 3 c. grated zucchini  
 1 small onion, grated or chopped  
 1 c. Bisquick  
 1/2 c. oil  
 3/4 c. grated cheese  
 1/4 tsp. salt  
 1/4 tsp. pepper  
 4 eggs  
 Combine all ingredients in large bowl & beat until fluffy with whisk. Pour in a casserole dish and bake fat 350° for 40 minutes or until done in center.

**Cajun Corn Soup**

*Ann Hughes Michalec '67*  
 1 cup chopped white onion  
 1 cup chopped green pepper  
 1/2 c. oil  
 2 cloves garlic, minced  
 1 can (6 oz) tomato paste  
 1/2 cup all purpose flour  
 1 can (14 1/2 oz) undrained Cajun style  
 3 cups water  
 stewed tomatoes  
 6 green onions, sliced  
 2 cups chopped, peeled tomatoes, undrained (I use canned)  
 2 pkg. (16 oz each) frozen whole kernel corn  
 3 cups cubed cooked ham  
 1 1/2 lb. cooked smoked sausage, sliced (like Hillshire)  
 1/8 tsp cayenne pepper or to taste ( I usually use more)  
 Tabasco and salt to taste

In at least a 6 quart Dutch oven, saute onion, pepper and garlic in oil till tender, about 5 min.  
 Add flour and cook until bubbly. Add water, all the tomatoes and tomato paste., mix well. Stir in the rest of the ingredients. Bring to a

boil, stirring frequently. Reduce heat and simmer UNCOVERED for at least an hour, stirring occasionally. Yield: 12-14 srvs.

Tip: It uses every bit of a 5 qt dutch oven so if you have something a little larger, use it. It's a great tasting, thick, hearty soup, just right for winter. I have used Spam in place of ham and it's not too bad but left over ham (or precut ham from the grocery) is better.

I've had trouble finding the Cajun tomatoes lately but can sub. Cajun seasoning to taste.

This soup freezes well and makes a very colorful presentation.

**Wheat Rosemary Breadsticks**

*Megan Vandecoevering '02*  
 1/4 TB active dry yeast  
 1/4 TB minced garlic  
 1/4 tsp sugar  
 2 TB finely grated cheddar cheese  
 1/4 cup water (110 degrees)  
 3/8 cup unbleached flour  
 1/4 tsp salt  
 1/4 cup whole wheat flour  
 1/2 TB walnut oil (can be replaced with canola or olive oil)  
 1 tsp dried rosemary (crushed)

Dissolve yeast and sugar into the warm water and let sit for 10 minutes. Stir in the salt, oil, rosemary, garlic and cheese. Add the flour slowly until the dough won't take any more (use remaining flour for next part).

Take the dough out of the bowl and place on a floured board or counter-top and knead for 10 minutes, adding flour to any sticky parts, until the dough is smooth and

elastic. Oil another bowl. Place the dough here making sure to turn the dough over a few times until entirely covered with the oil. Cover with a cloean cloth and let sit in a warm spot until the dough doubles in size (this will take about a half hour).

Punch the dough, which will collapse it. Preheat the oven to 400 degrees. Again on a floured surface, divide the dough into balls, then roll them out to form breadsticks. Place 1/4 inch apart on a non-stick sheet sprayed with cooking spray and bake for 15 minutes until nicely browned.

**Lentil Soup**

*Megan Vandecoevering '02*  
 chopped parsley  
 1 cup dried lentils  
 minced garlic  
 6 cups water  
 chopped dill  
 1 onion, chopped  
 chopped thyme  
 4 carrots, chopped  
 chopped taragon  
 2 stalks celery, chopped  
 salt and pepper to taste  
 1/2 can tomato paste  
 dry white wine (optional)

Rinse lentils in cold water. Pick over, taking out anything that isn't a lentil. Put first 5 ingredients in a pot and simmer gently for 1-1.5 hours, until lentils are tender. If you need to add more water, do so. Add herbs in whatever quantity you like, a little at a time. Add salt and pepper to taste. Stir in tomato paste and reheat.

(Goes nicely with the breadsticks)

Eunice Beal's Applesauce/Jell-o Salad

- Donna Krug Ramseyer Liechty '41*
- 3 3-oz. pkg lemon Jello
 - 6 Tbsp. coffee cream
 - 3/4 cup red hot cinnamon candies
 - 3 Tbsp. mayonnaise
 - 3 c. fine-texture applesauce
 - 3 c. hot water
 - 1 8-oz. pkg cream cheese

Dissolve the 3 packages of Jello in 2 cups of hot water. In a small saucepan, dissolve the cinnamon candies in 1 cup hot water on stove, stirring often. Add to Jello. Mix in the applesauce. Pour into a 9x13" pan. When it gets syrupy, mix the cream cheese, coffee cream and mayonnaise together thoroughly. Swirl into jello mixture. Let set in refrigerator.

Mexican Rice Chicken Salad

- Dicy Strom Graham, '63*
- 3 Cups cooked white rice
 - 1 green bell pepper- chopped
 - 1 med. size onion - chopped
 - 1 8-oz. pkg. frozen green peas
 - 3 or 4 cooked chicken breast - chopped
 - 1 Pint sour cream
 - 3 or 4 chopped avocados
 - minced garlic
 - 1/2 fresh lemon or lime juice

Blend the onion, pepper, & peas into the warm rice - brings the flavor together. You can serve the salad at room temperature or cold. It's delicious.

Serve with corn chips, salsa on top. Very colorful.

Spinach and Strawberry Salad

Megan Vandecoevering '02

Vinaigrette:

- 1/4 cup white wine vinegar
- 3 tablespoons honey
- 1/2 cup sliced fresh strawberries
- 1 tablespoon vegetable oil
- 1 tsp finely minced fresh ginger
- 1 tablespoon poppy seeds
- 2 tablespoons Dijon mustard

Glazed Almonds:

- 1/2 cup sliced almonds
- 2 tablespoons granulated sugar

Salad:

- 2 bunches spinach, stemmed, washed and spun dry (about 8 cups)
- 2 cups fresh strawberries, stemmed, quartered
- 1/2 cup thinly sliced sweet white onions (Walla Walla Sweets or Vidalia)

To make vinaigrette: Process vinegar, strawberries and ginger in blender or food processor until pureed. Combine mustard and honey in bowl. Whisk in pureed strawberry mixture and then slowly whisk in oil, emulsifying dressing until smooth. Stir in poppy seeds. Refrigerate until needed.

To make glazed almonds: Lightly spray baking sheet with nonstick cooking spray and set aside. Place almonds and sugar in nonstick skillet over high heat and stir with wooden spoon as sugar begins to dissolve and caramelize. Stir continuously to lightly toast almonds and coat with sugar. When almonds and sugar are dark amber and golden brown, quickly remove

from pan onto prepared baking sheet. Spread out with spoon and let cool completely. Break into pieces.

To make salad: Place spinach in large salad bowl. Toss with strawberries, onions and about 1/2 cup vinaigrette. Sprinkle glazed almonds on top. Reserve extra vinaigrette for another use or serve extra on side.

Apple Cheese Salad

Raggie Clites

- 1 c. hot water
- 1 8-oz. pkg. cream cheese (room temp)
- 2/3 c. cinnamon candies (Red hots)
- 1/2 c. finely chopped celery
- 1 pkg lemon gelatin (or any red Jello)
- 1/2 c. salad dressing
- 1 1/2 c. sweetened applesauce
- 1/2 c. chopped nuts

Pour hot water over cinnamon candies, stir until dissolved. Add applesauce. Pour half of the mixture into a pan or bowl, about 8x8" size. Chill until firm. Leave other half out at room temperature.

Blend together cheese at room temperature, nuts, celery, and salad dressing. Spread over set Jello mixture. Pour remaining Jell-o over top. Chill until firm.

Substitutes: use canned pears (mashed) for applesauce. You can use finely chopped cabbage instead of celery.
