Honorary Diplomas Awarded for 2013 Dr. Michael Kim

Dr. Michael Kim felt like a vagabond his whole life, moving 39 times in 38 years of his life, attending 5 different elementary schools, 2 different junior high schools and luckly attending I high school. But for the last 4 years, Dr Kim has called Silverton, Oregon: "HOME". He has always felt a community should not have silent and invisible citizens but have evervone come together to help anvone in need. He started his career by helping the Yakima Indian Tribe in Toppenish, WA and then moved on to serving in public health in Tacoma, WA.

Although Dr Kim enjoyed serving public health, he knew his compassion would always be limited if he worked under someone else's demands and expectations.

In 2008, Dr Kim decided to move to Silverton, Oregon to practice dentistry and raise his children. He has always believed the future of our children lied in the hands of our teachers, therefore, Dr. Kim has donated monies and supported Silver Falls School District by helping teachers obtain AP class certifications, supporting Robert Frost Outdoor School, donated towards new equipment to be used in all Science classes at Silverton High School, handing out scrub uniforms for Silverton High School's Animal Science Program, was a sponsor for Read Across America which helped provide books, assisted Scotts Mills Elementary with providing books for their library and aiding their Robotics program to be launched, sponsored Project Graduation for three years and providing warmup jackets and equipment bags for Lady Fox's Soccer team.

Dr. Kim and his staff decided in 2009 to host their own Food Drive for SACA to help stamp out hunger in Silverton by raising 10,000 pounds of food. So far, his office and volunteers has raised around 40,000 pounds of food and helped fund baskets of foods to be handed out during the holidays. His passion is dentistry but Dr Kim sees himself as a fanatic for baseball and has sponsored Silverton Area Athletics T-ball for the last two years.

Dr. Peter Andrew Loar

Dr. Peter and Claire Loar moved to Silverton in 1910 and constructed their home at 211 Coolidge Street in 1912. Dr. Loar took up the post of Silverton Health Officer and served in this capacity for 38 years before retiring in 1949. During that time, Dr. Loar became instrumental in establishing the Silverton Hospital. He served as president of the Marion-Polk Medical Society and was a member of state and national medical associations.

Active in civic affairs, Dr. Loar was a long-time member of the Silverton Planning Commission and president of the Cascade Highway Association. He also helped lead a movement to establish Silver Falls State Park.

Loar played a key role in building the community swimming pool, the water filtration plant, and the city's sewage system.

At the time of his death in 1959, through his estate, he established a Scholarship Fund for the benefit of graduates from Silverton High School. That Fund is managed by the Wells Fargo Bank and locally administered by the SHS Alumni Association. Since its inception approximately \$20,000 in annual scholarships have been awarded.

Class of '63 - Henk Schenk honored -50 years later

Yes, it has been 50 years, but who's counting? Even though our classmate Henk Schenk hasn't been on a wrestling mat for several decades, he is still being recognized for events that happened while we all were still at Silverton High.



In January or February of '63 (I can't remember the exact dates) right after the regular state wrestling tournament concluded, there was another tournament. This was a freestyle (international style) event to select the top contenders from around the state for the first cultural exchange team to be sent to Japan during that summer to compete against their top high school wrestlers.

Henk was already a state champion, and also won in his weight class in this new tournament, eventually prevailing in the follow-up workouts and traveling with the Oregon team to Japan. Henk was one of 4 team members to win all his matches in Japan, and the Oregon team won all their dual meets, finishing 9-0.

On Saturday, April 6, 2013, Henk and the rest of the surviving members of that team were honored at the Oregon Wrestling Hall of Fame banquet and gathered in Tigard at the Embassy Suites. Henk has already been inducted to the Oregon Hall of Fame. Among many other wrestling awards over his career, he took third in the world championships and represented the USA in two Olympic Games!

It was great to be able to attend the award presentation that weekend and to visit with Henk and a few other wrestling folks from so many years ago. As always, all I can say is, "Way to go, Henk!"

1 can fruit cocktail - 16 oz.

2 cans mandarin oranges - 11 oz.

1 can chunk pineapple - 20 oz.

2 or 3 sliced bananas

8 oz. whip cream (Cool Whip ok)

Hot Turkey Salad

2 cup diced cooked turkey

½ cup chopped Almonds

1 cup minced celery

1 tbsp minced onion

1/4 cup chopped green pepper

1 cup mayonnaise

½ tsp salt

2 tbsp lemon juice

½ tsp pepper

½ cup shredded cheddar cheese

1 cup crushed potato chips

When cooler, dribble mixture of 2 cups powered sugar and 1/3 cup milk or lemon juice mix over the top.

1 1/3 cup flour

4 eggs

1/2 teaspoon salt

1 1/3 cup milk

1 1/3 tablespoon shortening

Coat muffin tins or muffin tin cups with PAM. Sift flour and salt into mixing bowl. With pastry blender, cut in shortening. In small bowl, beat eggs slightly and beat in milk. Add to flour. Beat until smooth. Fill cups 1/2 full. Bake at 375° for 45 minutes, till lightly browned. Serve at once. (I do reheat leftover popovers.)

Greek Lemon Chicken

Megan Vandecoevering '02

(Suggestion: serve with couscous and broccoli or asparagus)

1 lemon

1/4 teaspoon salt

2 teaspoons dried oregano

1/4 tsp ground black pepper

3 cloves garlic, minced

6 chicken legs

1 tablespoon olive oil

Preheat over in 425 degrees F

In a 9x13 inch baking dish, grate the peel from 1/2 the lemon, squeeze out the juice (about 1/4 cup) and add to peel with the oregano, garlic, oil, salt and pepper. Stir until mixed.

Remove skin from chicken pieces and discard. Coat chicken pieces with the lemon mixture and arrange, bone side up, in the baking dish. Cover dish and bake for 20 minutes. Turn and baste chicken.

Reduce heat to 400 degrees F and bake uncovered, basting every 10 minutes for about 30 more minutes. Serve chicken with pan juices.

Smorgasbord Meat Balls

6 tsp. salt

8 eggs pepper to taste

4 c. water 8 small onions, grated

10 lb. meat (8 lb. beef, 2 lb. pork) double ground 8 dashes allspice

Beat eggs; add water, seasonings and onions. Add meat and crumbs and mix well. Shape into balls, size of walnuts. Serve with gravy made from meat fryings.

Quick & Easy Salmon

3 tablespoons lemon juice

2 tablespoon honey

1 tablespoon finely grated ginger

1 tablespoon light soy sauce

1 teaspoon cilantro

salt & pepper to taste

one pound to 1 1/2 pound salmon filet, rinsed and patted dry on a paper towel

Remove any bones that may be found in the salmon. Combine all the above ingredients in a pre-sprayed baking pan. Marinate salmon at least one hour in the refrigerator, turning twice. Bake in pre-heated 450 degree oven for 15-20 minutes, or, until the soft pink is completely gone from the center of the fish. Baste with the sauce and serve immediately.

This is a delicious way to serve salmon! I like to use Atlantic salmon.

Grandma Wikoff's Ginger Snaps

1 cup molasses

1/2 tsp. salt

1 cup sugar

1 cup lard and butter

2 tsp soda

2 heaping tsp ginger

1/2 cup hot water

flour to make smooth dough

Mix together molasses, sugar, shortening and hot water. Sift 3 cups flour with other dry ingredients and mix with liquid. Add rest of flour and mix till smooth. Chill at least 1 hour. Roll 1/4 inch thick. May need more flour. Bake at 350° for 10-12 minutes; watch - don't burn. Makes nice gingerbread people.

Broccoli Cheese Souffle

Judy Nunn '60

2 lb. pkg frozen, chopped broccoli, cooked & drained (see shortcut below)

1 cup grated cheddar cheese

1/2 cup mayonnaise

1 can cream of celery soup (alt: mushroom or chicken soup)

2 eggs

Mix together all ingredients except eggs. FOLD in the eggs and put all in 2-quart baking dish. To double the recipe (I always have to), use **two** 2-lb. pkg. broccoli, 3/4 cup mayo and 3 eggs. No need to double the soup.

Bake at 350° for 45 minutes. You can microwave for 25-30 minutes, but it doesn't rise like it will in the oven.

Broccoli shortcut: Just stick in microwave for 5 minutes - be sure to poke holes in the bag first, and I

always put paper towels under the bag so the ink from the bag doesn't mark the oven floor. There's no liquid this way, so no draining is necessary.

Chocolate Peanut Butter Pie

1 Chocolate or Graham cracker crust

Mix Together:

1 Large pkg cream cheese

1 cup peanut butter

1 ½ cup powdered sugar

Fold in one 16 oz. Cool Whip or less. Drizzle chocolate syrup in crust first, then top with chocolate syrup and refrigerate. mmmm - Good!

3 Tbls. catsup


