Honorary Diplomas - 2014

Bette Kuenzi

*Elizabeth R. "Bette" Kuenzi –
Class of 2014
(1943-2013)*

Bette Kuenzi first became associated with Silverton while working on an uncle's farm during the summers as a teenager. While attending University of Oregon she met and married Lowell Kuenzi, SHS Class of 1961. Together they founded the Pacific Sanitation Company and she became the Office Manager. While associated with their Company she became the first woman to chair the Oregon Refuse and Recycling Association. She also was another first for women when she chaired the West Coast Recycling Coalition for Oregon, Washington, California and Nevada. Bette helped create and implement the Oregon Bottle Bill in 1972.

Bette served the greater Silverton Area in many leadership capacities. She was the Outreach Coordinator for Chemeketa Community College, Manager for the Family Clinic, President of Silverton Junior Women and chaired the 1986 Detroit Water Festival.

She was elected as the first woman member of the Silver Falls School District Board. She also became the first woman to serve as Chair of the Board. During her tenure she was very instrumental in establishing and expanding the girls' sports opportunities. The tennis courts were built during her time on the school board.

Bette has had a husband, two children, four grandchildren and a daughter-in-law graduate from Silverton High School.

Frances McCarty

Frances McCarty was an Army Brat who moved with her three siblings to and from California and Washington State, with a short station in Alaska and a longer one in Hawaii. Her family finally settled in Lakewood, Washington, where Frances graduated from Lakes High School.

Frances attended the University of Washington for both her undergraduate and graduate studies; also working at the Experimental Education Unit there for a number of years before meeting and marrying her husband, Philip Virga.

They settled in Scotts Mills and Frances was fortunate to land a Structured Learning Plan teaching position at Robert Frost, where she worked for 14 years before moving to the Learning Resource Center at the high school in 2000. This allowed her to be at the same school as her daughter, Cherie.

Frances has been instrumental in helping dozens of students graduate from Silverton High School who otherwise might not have done so. Frances is one of the first teachers in the building and often-times one of the last to leave. She is one of the hardest working educators to ever walk the halls of Silverton High School. Her students would say she held them to high standards while always showing how much she truly cared about them. Frances is a Master Teacher in every sense of the word.

Besides hanging out with her husband, Frances enjoys horses, dogs, birds, gardening and occasionally working at the Chocolate Box.

Silverton High School has enthusiastically endorsed the awarding of Honorary SHS diplomas to the greater Silverton area community members who have made significant contributions to the education of our next generation(s) of Foxes.

Buttermilk Chicken

Marcia & Mason Branstetter '63

8 slices bread
 1 cup buttermilk
 1 tsp. hot pepper sauce
 salt & pepper
 3/4 grated Parmesan cheese (2 1/2 oz.)
 1 tsp. dried thyme
 4 pounds chicken parts

1. Preheat oven to 400°. Generously rub baking sheet with oil. Pulse bread until it turns coarse.
2. In large bowl, mix buttermilk, hot pepper, 3/4 tsp salt, 1/2 tsp. pepper. In separate bowl mix crumbs, Parmesan, thyme, 3 1/8 tsp. pepper.
3. Place chicken in buttermilk mixture. Coat evenly one piece at a time. Then dredge in crumb mix. Place on baking sheet. Bake until chicken is golden brown, about 35 minutes.

White Chocolate Fruit Tart

Jeanette Olafson '57

3/4 c. butter
 1 1/2 c. flour
 1/2 c. confectioners sugar

Cream butter and sugar. Gradually add flour; mix well. Press into 11" tart pan or 12" pizza pan with sides. Bake at 300° for 25-30 minutes until lightly browned. Cool.

Filling:

1 (10-oz.) pkg. vanilla baking chips, melted
 1 pt. fresh strawberries, sliced
 1/4 c. whipping cream
 1 (11-oz.) can mandarin oranges, drained
 1 (8-oz.) pkg. cream cheese, softened
 4 kiwi, peeled & sliced
 1 (20-oz.) can pineapple chunks

Beat melted chips and cream. Add cream cheese and beat until smooth. Spread over crust. Chill 30 minutes. Drain pineapple, reserving 1/2 c. juice. Make glaze; cool.

Arrange strawberries, pineapple, oranges and kiwi over filling. Brush cooled glaze over filling. Chill 1 hour before serving. Store in refrigerator. 12-16 servings.

Glaze:

3 T. sugar
 1/2 tsp. lemon juice
 2 tsp. cornstarch
 1/2 c. pineapple juice

In saucepan, combine sugar, cornstarch, lemon juice and pineapple juice; bring to a boil over medium heat. Boil 2 minutes until thickened, stirring constantly. Cool.

Apple Crisp

In greased 9x13" pan, put peeled & sliced apples to reach top (or blueberries & Marionberries). Mix 1 cup sugar, 1 tsp. vanilla, 2 tsp. cinnamon and sprinkle over fruit as adding fruit to pan for crisp topping.

Mix 1/2 cup butter (softened), 1 cup flour, 1 1/3 cup brown sugar, 1 cup oatmeal. Sprinkle this mix on top of sweetened fruit. (can cover and freeze now).

Bake 350° for 1 hour. Good with ice cream on top.

Pistachio Coconut Cake

Don & Doris David '42

1 pkg. (14 1/2 oz.) white cake mix without pudding
 3/4 cup vegetable oil
 3 eggs
 1 cup chopped pecans
 1 cup lemon-lime club soda
 1 1/2 cup flaked coconut
 1 pkg. (3.4 oz.) instant pistachio pudding mix

Icing

1 envelope whipped topping mix
 1 1/2 cups milk
 1 pkg. (3.4 oz.) instant pistachio

pudding mix 3/4 cup chopped pecans
 1/2 cup coconut

In bowl, add the first five ingredients, mix well. Stir in pecans and coconut. Pour into a greased and floured 13x9x2" baking pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes or until cake tests done. Cool.

In another bowl, combine the first three icing ingredients and beat until thickened (about 4 minutes). Spread over cake. Sprinkle with pecans and coconut.

Makes 12 to 15 servings.

Pickled Beans

2 lb. green beans (makes 4 pints)
 2 tsp. cayenne pepper
 4 cloves garlic
 4 heads dill
 2 1/2 cups water
 2 1/2 cups vinegar
 1/4 cup salt

Pack green beans in jars; put dill & clove garlic in bottom and top of jars. Divide ingredients between the 4 jars. Boil water, vinegar & salt, add to the 4 jars. Process in boiling water bath for 10 minutes. Leave set for at least 10 days before using.
