New Grant Program Established for SHS Music Department

We are excited to announce a new Grant program that has been established to benefit the Silverton High School Music programs. As a result of a recent donation by Donna Strom, Class of 1960, we have established the Doug and Donna Strom Music Grant. This grant program is for the exclusive use by the Silverton High School Choir and Band programs to apply for funds that directly benefit the Silverton High School Choir or Band related missions or special projects.

Donna stated that although her husband Doug “couldn’t carry a note in a basket”, she has very fond memories of her years being active in the choir programs at Silverton High School. She participated in Acapella Choir and Triple Trio during her years at Silverton High.

In 2013 Donna established the Doug Strom Memorial Scholarship to provide an annual scholarship to a Silverton High School graduate who demonstrates a strong entrepreneurial spirit that could lead to a career in private business. Doug graduated from Linfield College with a degree in Business with an emphasis on advertising. When it became apparent that a position in his chosen profession was not readily available, he started working in retail as a Taco Bell franchisee and through his diligence and a strong entrepreneurial spirit, he became a multi-unit franchisee and was one of the first 100 franchisees of the Taco Bell chain. His scholarship is awarded annually to an alumnus to Silverton High who

appears to share Doug’s determination and entrepreneurial spirit. Doug passed away in 1999 at the age of 57, however his memory is kept alive with this scholarship and with this new music grant program.

We are pleased to announce that we have awarded the first grant this year to the Silverton High School Music department. Their project is entitled “Building a collaborative combined band and choir repertoire library.” Their application for funding is to create and fill a new category of repertoire in their music library which will allow for direct collaboration between the band and choir students. Their goal is to be able to study and perform the same music together, which will provide these students with meaningful musical experiences, as well as provide enriching and memorable events for the local community.

The project centers around the idea that through collaboration in performance, the music department at Silverton HS can achieve greater audiences, have a larger impact on the community, and reach students that have not been introduced to the musical offerings that are available at the high school. We firmly believe that every aspiring musician, and those that don’t yet know they are aspiring musicians, deserve the chance to be part of a band and/or choir, complete with all the essential elements that make such an endeavor truly memorable.

Donna is excited to be able to provide this grant opportunity to

enhance the Silverton High School music program during a time when many school districts are considering cutting back or eliminating their music programs due to budget cuts. This grant fund is open to additional donations and She is encouraging others to consider making donations to increase the available funds for this grant program. By Laws Changes

A special meeting of the membership was held on February 18, 2025 to make revisions to the By Laws. Notice was given via email and postcard to the paid membership, as well as on our website. The proposed revisions were also made available on the website. The reasons for the revisions were to bring the By Laws in line with how the Board of Trustees is currently doing business, some minor house-keeping updates and to add the ability for the Association to receive monies to use as grants for departments of Silverton High School, in addition to our already established scholarship funding program.

2025 Class Challenge

The Class of 1959 initiated the Class Challenge in 2017 as a friendly competition between classes to raise funds for scholarships and support our students. Every year numerous classes have participated and contributed significantly to the scholarship fund. Since 2017, the SHSAA Class Challenge has raised \$262,000 for scholarships.

Funds raised from donations will be invested by the Alumni Association solely for the purpose of having a perpetual income for scholarship funds to Silverton High School graduating seniors and graduates.

Classes with the top 3 donation totals will have a scholarship awarded in their name to a 2025 graduate. Class Challenge winners will be announced at the Annual Alumni and Friends Reunion party on August 1, 2025.

You can donate in two ways: write and check and use the Class Challenge lines of the Membership/ Donation form on page 15 or make a payment on our website. Remember dues, memorials and other designated donations will not be included in the Class Challenge.

All donations must be received in our office by **Monday, July 28, 2025** to be included in the 2025 Class Challenge.

If you are required to take a distribution from your IRA this year, consider making a **Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)** donation to the SHSAA 2025 Class Challenge. A QCD allows you to donate directly from your taxable IRA instead of taking the required minimum distribution, potentially lowering your taxable income. Consult with your IRA custodian or tax advisor for more information.

Let's make this year's Class Challenge the best yet to help young Foxes wanting to continue their education!

person and virtually. Terms of office for the President, Vice President and Trustees were clarified to begin immediately at the membership meeting at which they are elected. The number of Trustees elected was set at a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 9. A quorum for Trustee meetings was identified. The requirement for a Finance Committee was added.

The focus of the Alumni Association has been to provide scholarships to graduating seniors and graduates of Silverton High School. We added language to the By Laws to allow the Association to accept monies in order to provide grants to individual departments of the High School to supplement their annual budget. The first monies have been received and a grant program for the Music Department has been established (see the article on page 1). As with the scholarship program, the grant program will require an application which outlines specifically how the money will be used.

Additional grant programs can be established for other departments. Talk with Tracy Duerst, Treasurer, to see what is needed to create a program.

Qualified Charitable Distributions:

Reduce your tax bill when you donate to SHSAA Scholarship Fund

The Internal Revenue Service allows IRA owners age 70½ or over to transfer up to \$105,000 to charity tax-free each year. These transfers, known as qualified charitable distributions or QCDs, offer eligible older Americans a great way to easily give to charity before the end of the year. Moreover, for those who are at least 72, QCDs count toward the IRA owner's required minimum distribution (RMD) for the year.

Summary of qualified gifts:

- You are age 70½ or older at the time of the gift.
- You transfer up to \$105,000 directly from your IRA. This applies only to IRAs and no other types of retirement plans.
- You transfer the funds outright to one or more qualified charities. Transfers to charitable trusts, donor advised funds, charitable gift annuities, private foundations, or supporting organizations are not permitted.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Can my gift be used as my minimum required distribution under the law?

A. Yes. If you have not yet taken your required minimum distribution, the QCD can satisfy all or part of that requirement. Any amount that is donated in excess of your RMD does not create any additional tax benefit, and the excess is not eligible to be carried forward.

Q: Should I make a QCD or just write a check/give appreciated shares to the qualifying organization I wish to support?

A. Tax changes made it less likely that donors will itemize deductions, instead opting to claim a higher standard deduction. For that reason, it may be more tax-effective to make a

QCD as any amount processed as a QCD counts toward your RMD requirement and reduces the taxable amount of your IRA distribution. This lowers both your adjusted gross income and taxable income, resulting in a lower overall tax liability.

Q. I'm turning age 70½ in a few months. Can I make this gift now?

A. No. The legislation requires you to reach age 70½ by the date you make the gift.

Q. I have several retirement accounts—some are pensions and some are IRAs. Does it matter which retirement account I use?

A. Yes. QCDs to a qualified charity can only be made from an IRA. Under certain circumstances, however, you may be able to roll assets from a pension, profit sharing, 401(k) or 403(b) plan into an IRA and then make the donation.

Q. I have two charities I want to support. Can I give \$105,000 from my IRA to each?

A. No. Under the law, you can give a maximum of \$105,000. You can split the \$100,000 among multiple charities. Any amount of more than \$105,000 in one year must be reported as taxable income.

Q. My spouse and I would like to give more than \$105,000. How can we do that?

A. If your spouse is 70½ or older and has an IRA, he or she can also give up to \$100,000 from his or her IRA.

Please consult with your tax and finance professionals if you are contemplating a charitable gift.

What does a Class Representative Do?

A Class Representative is a contact person for a designated class year – the year you graduated.

It is assumed that this person will keep track of classmates in order to make preparations for a reunion at 5, 10, or 20 years. The more often you have reunions, the easier it is to keep track of everyone. The Class Representative doesn't have to plan the reunion by themselves – they can enlist other classmates to help.
