The Class Challenge started in 2017 by the graduating class of '59. That year 7 classes raised \$3,400. Fast forward six years later and \$217,845 has been raised for scholarships. As we approach 2024, we will continue The Class Challenge. This has become a fantastic way of raising money and supporting our future students.

Classes are greatly encouraged to accept the Challenge and help us continue to support Silverton High Students. The top 3 classes will have a scholarship awarded in their name to a 2024 graduate. Class Challenge winners will be announced at the Annual Alumni and Friends Reunion party August 2, 2024.

Keep in mind, what started out as a simple idea turned into a great scholarship fundraiser. The 2023 Silverton graduating class received a total of \$89,250 in scholarship funds that were awarded to 91 students.

The funds raised from donations will be invested by the Silverton High School Alumni Association solely for the purpose of having a perpetual income for scholarship funds to Silverton public high school graduates and to graduating Silverton high school seniors. Let's make this a record setting year of class participants and donors.

Silverton High Alumni Scholarship Awards: We Help Foxes Go to College!

The Silverton High School Alumni Association (SHSAA) is thrilled to celebrate the scholarship season! This exciting and busy time allows us to recognize deserving students embarking on their college journeys and help them finance their education.

Thanks to the unwavering generosity of our alumni donors, the SHSAA will award an impressive \$97,000 in scholarships this year to students who will be attending college full time during the 2024-25 school year. This amount is determined by calculating 5% of the 2023 year-end balance in our investment account. This year's allocation surpasses last year's, reflecting both a rise in our investment portfolio's value and the continued support of our dedicated donors.

This year we received 105 applications which are currently undergoing a thorough review process. During the month of April, dedicated teams of evaluators are carefully assessing each application for completeness and scoring them based on established criteria.

This year, we're proud to introduce a new online application system. This new platform streamlines the application and evaluation process, allowing reviewers to conveniently access and score applications at their own pace, eliminating the need for bulky boxes of paper applications to be transferred between evaluators. The student applicants did a great job with the new system and many found it easier than the paper application process. So far, the evaluators have also enjoyed the ease of the new system. Reviewers can now access and score applications remotely, all they need is an internet connection and a computer. This means they can catch up on applications at their own pace, even while enjoying a sunny beach getaway or soaking up the spring sun as a snowbird!

Following the evaluation stage, the scholarship committee will meet to allocate the \$97,000 scholarship funds amongst the winning applicants. The final selection involves a detailed comparison of scores from the evaluators, with applicants ranked by quartile to determine their respective award amounts. Amounts usually range from \$500 to \$2,000 each depending on the number of qualified applicants we distribute the funds to.

High school award recipients will be honored in person at the Senior Awards Night on May 30th. They will receive a certificate and a personalized award letter acknowledging their achievement with detailed instructions on how to claim their award. All other applicants, both selected and non-selected, will be notified of the outcome via a letter mailed out on May 30th. Non-selected applicants will receive a standard notification letter, while post-high school award winners will receive a letter detailing their specific scholarship award and how to claim the funds.

Since our first scholarship award of \$100 in 1996, SHSAA has awarded \$1,580,650 to 1,983 SHS graduates. Those are pretty impressive numbers for a small town! We are always looking for volunteers to help us evaluate applications. If you would like to help next year, please send an email to silvertonalumni@gmail. com.

How Can I be a Class Representative?

We are often asked about the list of Class Reps in the back of the newsletter. "What do I have to do?" is the most common question.

Relax - there are no "duties". A Class Representative is mainly a contact person for a designated class year.

We would presume that person would be keeping track of classmates in order to make preparations for a reunion at 5, 10 or 20 years. The more often you have a reunion, the easier it is to keep track of everyone.

It's a great help when the Class Rep is notified by anyone who moves or changes his/her name. And some classes have better luck than others.

In addition to editing the newsletter, I also keep the Alumni database up to date. The Class Reps help by sending me the changes of address for their classmates. This is a constant job. I am always receiving Emails with address changes.

Reunion Preparation:

Most reunions are held after a 5-year period (5, 10, 15, 20, etc.). Each year we concentrate on whatever year ends in a 5-year period from the date of graduation. For instance, for 2022 we mailed complimentary copies of the newsletter to all classes ending in 7 and 2.

Both this newsletter and the June (2023) issue will be sent to those classes ending in 3 and 8. Contact us if your class will have a reunion in 2023.

Let this be a "heads up" to *you*. Start working on your mailing list now. We suggest you begin with a list from the Alumni Association. Request a class roster, compare it with what information you currently have, and work from there. The Post Office does not forward our newsletters. If one is sent out with a bad address (i.e., to someone who has moved), the newsletter is returned to us at a cost of 67¢. If the move has been within the past six months, the Post Office will provide us with a current address. Many times, however, we pay for the return only to get it stamped with "Moved - No Forwarding Address" or "FOE" (Forwarding order expired).

So let's work together. Contact me for a Class Roster. Let me help you get a head start on your reunion for next year. If you'd like to check our list, just send an Email to: Nunnjk@comcast.net. Be sure to **put your class year in the subject line**. You may phone me with the request at (503) 390-3816 - leave a message if I'm not home and **PLEASE be sure to leave your area code and phone number** in case I have to contact you.
