SHSAA Awards Two New Named Scholarships in 2026

The Silverton High School Alumni Association (SHSAA) is proud to continue its tradition of investing in our youth by introducing two new scholarship opportunities for 2026. We are honored to announce **The Carmen Joy Cochran Smith Scholarship** and **The Roger and Lisa Freeman Scholarship**. These awards represent a growing commitment from our alumni and community members to support the diverse dreams and academic pursuits of the next generation of Foxes.

Carmen Joy Cochran was born May 4, 1943 in Salem, Oregon – the only child of Verl and Doris Hadley Cochran. She moved to Silverton in 1954 when her dad got a contract to run the school buses in the area. In 1961 Carmen graduated from SUHS where she had remarkable achievements including - third highest GPA in her class, Girl's State, Girl of the Month, TNT President, Best Actress in "Time Out for Ginger" and "The Perfect Idiot," Thespians, and Prom Princess. She met the love of her life, John Smith in the 6th grade at Eugene Field School in Silverton. According to John "Carmen was the nicest, cutest and one of the 3 smartest girls" in their class. John played baseball and basketball and served in leadership positions including Student Body President.

After high school they went to Oregon State University. They married in 1963 and moved to New Orleans in 1964 when John accepted a position with the Boeing Company. Carmen graduated from the University of New Orleans in 1969 with a biology degree (she was delayed a few years raising their wonderful daughter Debby).

In 1969 John left Boeing and they started a personnel service "Professional Staffing." Over 26 years they built a business with offices in

six states and about 60 full time employees. In 1996 they sold the business and bought a summer home in Silverton. For more than 20 years they were intensely involved with helping to create and fund the SHSAA. Carmen passed away in 2025 after a brief battle with pancreatic cancer.

This scholarship is awarded to high school graduates who had good grades, participated in high school activities, and have financial needs. Being the nicest, cutest and one of the 3 smartest in the class is not a requirement – but it might help.

The Roger and Lisa Freeman scholarship is for students who have a desire and passion to pursue a career in Crop Agriculture (e.g. Horticulture, Agronomy, Forestry, Plant Science, Agri-Business) or Engineering, and that have shown strong academic performance at SHS.

Roger and Lisa Freeman have lived in the Silverton area for over 40 years, and raised three children that all graduated from Silverton High School. Roger and Lisa met at Texas A&M University and both graduated with degrees in horticulture. While Roger was in graduate school for his Ph.D. at the University of Wisconsin, Lisa worked in the USDA cucumber breeding program there. Both Roger and Lisa have had a lifelong passion working with, and around plants, including vegetables, ornamentals, trees and native plants.

Roger was a commercial carrot breeder for over 40 years. He developed many new carrot varieties that are used throughout the world, focusing his breeding work on carrot production for USA and Canada. Important improvements were made in disease resistance, flavor, quality, and field performance. Roger's work resulted in the key varieties of carrots being sold by the USA grocers/processors for the past 30 years.

These new awards are a testament to the power of a legacy. If you are interested in honoring a loved one or

I recently went through the stock of old newsletters on file in our office. It's interesting to see the changes in format over the years. Class Challenge Is Open

The Class Challenge program began in 2017 when the class of 1959 gave a \$59 donation to the annual silent auction (held during the Scholarship Fundraiser). They challenged other classes to also make similar cash donations to support the SHSAA scholarship fund. Several classes accepted that challenge. At the 2017 Annual Membership meeting it was determined to provide a scholarship in the name of the “winning” class each year in the amount of \$1,000. This was later changed to three scholarships in the name of the classes with the top three donation totals and in the amounts of \$1,500, \$1,000 and \$750.

For the past several years, all donations not specifically designated as dues, memorials, or named scholarships went towards the Class Challenge. This meant that many donors may not have been aware their donation was counted as part of the Class Challenge. At a recent Trustee meeting, it was agreed we would go back to the original intent of the Challenge as a specific fund-raising source. Therefore, to be counted towards the Class Challenge, you must specifically designate your donation to the Challenge. An anticipated result of this change may be that the total dollars raised through the Challenge will be less than what we have reported in previous years.

This year’s Class Challenge is open and we have already received some donations. To make a donation, you can write a check and, using the membership form on page 15, mail it to the SHSAA office in Silverton. Another option is to make payment on our website at shsfoxes.com/give and using the Class Challenge 2026 link.

All donations must be received in our office by Friday, July 31, 2026 to be included in the 2026 Class

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Challenge. The winning classes will be announced at the Alumni and Friends Reunion Party on Thursday, August 6, 2026. Let’s encourage our classmates to step up and “meet the challenge”.

The Silverton High School Alumni Association wants you. The new group is looking for SHS graduates in an attempt to build an active alumni association that will provide information on alumni activities and raise funds for scholarships. The Alumni Association is an arm of the Silver Fox Foundation, whose other offshoots include the group of parents who coordinate Project Graduation Party and another group involved with fundraising for the high school football program.

The idea for an alumni association came from the Class of 1963. "After our 30-year reunion was over, we were wondering what we could do for the high school with the \$900 we had left over," said local Realtor Mason Branstetter. "There wasn't really enough money to do something significant, so we started thinking about

using the money to start an alumni trust, and then build it to the point at which the interest could be used for scholarships."

The trust was established with the Class of '63's \$900, and a gift of \$1,000 from an anonymous alum soon followed. To help the group reach its goal of \$100,000, the SHS Alumni Association was formed. SHS grads can join the association for just \$5 per year.

An alumni scholarship was officially established with the policy that the contributions would remain as invested principal and only the interest would be given out as scholarships. We currently have \$2,500 in the fund.

Our goal for the scholarship fund is to collect \$100,000. When invested we expect to be able to present approximately \$8,000 in interest annually to graduating Seniors. . The first scholarship was awarded to Emily A. Wallace. Future scholarships will make a major difference in whether some graduates will be able to fulfill their dreams of attending college.

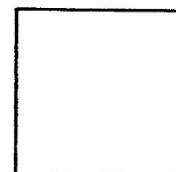

As we celebrate our milestones and look back on the years since we walked the stage at Silverton High, we often think about the legacy we want to leave behind. For many Foxes, that includes a gift to the **Silverton High School Alumni Association (SHSAA)** to support the scholarships that help the next generation of Silverton students.

However, there is a technical detail from our history that could impact your future gift.

The "1996 vs. 2005" Milestone

When SHSAA was founded in 1996, we operated under the umbrella and Tax ID number of the Silver Fox Foundation. It was a wonderful "launchpad" for our organization, but as we grew, so did our need for independence.

In 2005, SHSAA officially became an independent 501(c)(3) non-profit organization with our own unique Tax ID number.

Why This Matters Today

If you established a life insurance policy, a retirement account (like an IRA or 401k), a Trust, or a Will **prior to 2005** and named the Alumni Association as your beneficiary, the funds may not automatically reach us as you intended.

To ensure your gift supports the SHSAA mission, please take a moment to review your designations:

- **Our Name:** Ensure the beneficiary is listed as **Silverton High School Alumni Association.**

- **Our Tax ID:** Verify that your documentation uses our independent Tax ID: **20-2021613.**
- **Our Address:** 303 Oak Street, Silverton, OR 97381

Most beneficiary changes can be completed online in just a few minutes through your bank or insurance provider's portal. By confirming these details today, you ensure that your support for Silverton's students remains secure for the next 50 years and beyond.

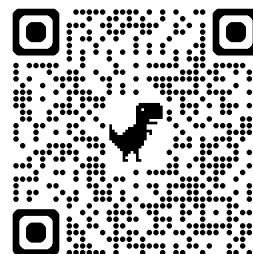
